What's Changing?

On **Wednesday, October 2, 2024**, we will make changes listed below. These updates were installed in the Drupal **stage environment** on **Wednesday, September 11, 2024**.

Testing Guidance

The OIT Drupal team has created [a testing rubric](#) to help site owners identify the level of testing they should perform for each platform release. While the rubric should help to identify the general level of testing, these communications may include specific components which require additional testing.

For this release, we have drupal core, patches, and module updates including multiple updates to prepare for Drupal 11. The specificity of button css selectors has changed and could possibly cause changes with sub-theme styling for buttons. We recommend following the guidance for **level 3**.

- Drupal core update to 10.3.2
- The Custom Block Library changed location in the Admin Menu. It now exists under Content/Blocks.

Patches

- Fixed - Layout Builder modal intermittently does not close when expected

- Patched Lightning Scheduler for 10.3.2 compatibility
- Refactored patch to redirect to original destination after login

Folwell

- Fixed line spacing in ordered and unordered list
- Adjusted Folwell utility classes so that button colors appear correctly when nested within other elements using utility classes

Modules

- Update [Environment Indicator](#) to the latest version
- Updating ImageMagick to its next major version: 4.0.1
- Updating a [number of modules](#)
- Updating Menu Block module to 1.13 and fixed styling conflict with Folwell.

Drupal Lite

- Added pronouns field to Drupal Lite Biography content type.

The **update will begin at 8 AM** on October 2nd and is expected to be completed by 1 pm. There will be no downtime during the update window.
